# Our Programs.

## During 2006 We Must:

- Address and implement the key recommendations of the Blue Ribbon Panel that are reasonably within our power.
- Identify key tracts of private land that offer realistic opportunities for public parks, trails and open space, and adopt a concrete and achievable plan for realizing those opportunities.
- Effectuate a final and workable resolution of the South Suburban exclusion litigation.
- Fund and commence construction of a fit-for-purpose Village Center and Village Commons that will provide:
  - Efficient, usable office space for our city staff;
  - Facilities necessary to support an effective, well-trained, 24-hour police force;
  - Space for storage and maintenance of public works equipment;
  - Effective 21<sup>st</sup> Century technology for communication within and with city government; and
  - Adequate space for our municipal court, for community meetings and events and for other occasional uses.
- Achieve the foregoing without an increase in our mill levy, which has not increased since 1989.
- Improve cellular telephone communications for all our citizens.
- Expand the utilization of our dedicated cable Channel 22 by the City, by our schools and by all of our Citizens.
- Increase our communication with all of our citizens by a concerted commitment to the full and consistent utilization of our CIVIC process (The Crier, the Internet, the Villager, Cable Channel 22).
